1) Keating Support

Town Administrator Pacheco stated the he would like to thank the folks at PJ Keating for supplying the material to assist in making repairs to Pine Hill Road. Thanks to Mr. John Kanis as well, for his use of equipment and labor.

2) Town Clock MOU

Town Administrator Pacheco has drafted a MOU regarding ownership and maintenance responsibilities of the Town Clock at the First Church. The MOU has been reviewed by the Historical Commission. He is going to send it for comment to the Church's Standing Committee in hope to have a final version ready.

3) SeeClickFix

Mr. Pacheco reached out to the company and working under the state contract the Town would be able to get the service for \$4,900 for 12 months. The previous quote was \$8,000.

4) STM

Under the municipal modernization act the Town can lease space for a term of 30 years or less without Town Meeting approval. The Community Center Kitchen article was removed and Mr. Pacheco has advised World Farmer's to work on supplying a draft lease to move forward with the project.
