

# LANCASTER BOARD OF SELECTMEN REGULAR MEETING MINUTES FOR NOVEMBER 6, 2017

### I. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Stanley B. Starr, Jr. called the Regular Meeting of the Board of Selectmen to Order at 6:30 P.M. in the Mary Rowlandson Elementary School Auditorium, 103 Hollywood Drive, Lancaster, Massachusetts. Present were Selectmen Walter F. Sendrowski, Mark A. Grasso, Jr., Town Administrator Orlando Pacheco and Executive Assistant Kathleen Rocco.

## IV. TOWN ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

#### 1) Dispatch

- A) M. Ross Klun has been officially hired as the new Executive Director of the Nashoba Valley Regional Dispatch District.
- B) With Mr. Klun adjusting to his new role the district plans to proceed with the integration of the Town of Townsend into the District which will take place in the coming months.

### 2) SeeClixFix

The Board has been provided a contract to implement the program at a cost of \$4,900. (Attachment provided)

#### 3) Electric Aggregation Program

The Town was able to obtain a 6 month extension on the aggregation rate to residents in the amount of 12.0 cents per KWH, compared to the National Grid rate of 12.67 cents per KWH. For a home using 1,000 KWH a month this translates into a savings of \$6.70 per month.

## 4) Job Postings

Town Administrator reported that the Facilities Maintenance Specialist and Recreation Director positions have been posted with a response deadline of November 22<sup>nd</sup>. It was also noted that the Administrative Assistant position to the Police Chief has been posted as well, with a deadline date of November 10<sup>th</sup>.

## 5) Surplus Land RFP

A RFP's has been prepared for the sale of the property at 0 Packard Street. Responses to the RFP are due 12/1/2017.

## 6) FY19 Budget

The Finance Committee has sent out the preliminary budget schedule and timeline for responses back to the Finance Director and Town Administrator for review. Mr. Pacheco stated that they are working on the Capital items as they go through the operating budgets with departments.

## 7) Solar Array Production (4 year update)

From September 25<sup>th</sup> 2013 thru September 25<sup>th</sup>, 2017, the Solar Array has produced 2,398,000 KWH. Town Administrator noted that using an equalized rate of .17 cents per KWH, that would produce a value of \$407,660.
