	monitored for now. When the contractor gains	
	access to the roof for mechanical work the leak

	needs to be caulked.	
	10.15.17 additional leaks were discovered at the

	inspected. The major steel items are now

	10.15.17 Nelco has a couple steel items remaining
	on the punch list.
6.14.17.1	NGRD has not responded to multiple emails and
	phone calls. Energy Electric has not received an
	approved design or transformer delivery date.
	7.19.17 Design approval received from NGRD.
	Town issued check to NGRD. Waiting for delivery
	date.
	8.9.17 NRGD contacted MB to initiate a precon
	meeting. Nelco will set up precon meeting with
	NGRD and Energy Electric.
	9.13.17 Nelco is coordinating trenching with
	NGRD. Inspection is required before back fill.
	NGRD will not establish transformer delivery dates
	until trench and transformer pad have been
	approved.
	10.15.17 Due to multiple hurricanes this year the
	team still does not have a date for the
	transformer.
	The Community center has lost power
	complicating the transformer delivery. NGRD has
	determined the current pad at Prescott could
	accommodate a larger transformer that could
	supply both facilities.
8.9.17	Nelco has requested the window information for
	the community to replace the damage window.
	9.13.17 Nelco has the window supplier
