Chapter 61A Discussion – Ag. Com. reviewed more 61A property maps the following lots were discussed.

Lot 152A – 24 acre property would be a good agricultural property if the access was from 152J (shown as Lancaster property). Otherwise access would need to be from the lot with the house on it. Recommendation would depend on street access on Brazao Lane or Main Street.

Lot 10A - 9.64 acre property would not be recommended for agricultural property as it would need to be separated from house, not enough hay fields to benefit farming.

Lot 1C – 193.79 acre property would recommend use for agricultural land and would definitely benefit farming.

Sludge on farm fields – Sludge has not been tested for forever chemicals prior to going on farm fields. Peter will contact Farm Bureau to see the current position of the State. At this time Lancaster Ag. Com. would not recommend farmers using this sludge without further research.
