

## **Lancaster Board of Health – COVID-19 Update, September 4, 2021**

With COVID-19 infections rates continuing to increase largely due to the Delta variant the BOH continues to work for the safety of our residents. We have instituted a Town-wide mandate required face coverings for all person ages 2 and older, regardless of vaccination status, when indoors in public spaces. The vaccination rate in Lancaster continues to be unacceptably low at 51%, see table below. It is likely the Delta variant will be followed by other, potentially more contagious, and virulent mutations, and unless we improve our immunization rate we will see many more infections, and potentially hospitalizations and deaths, in the near future.

The BOH implores town residents to get vaccinated, and to encourage family, friends, and colleagues to do the same. 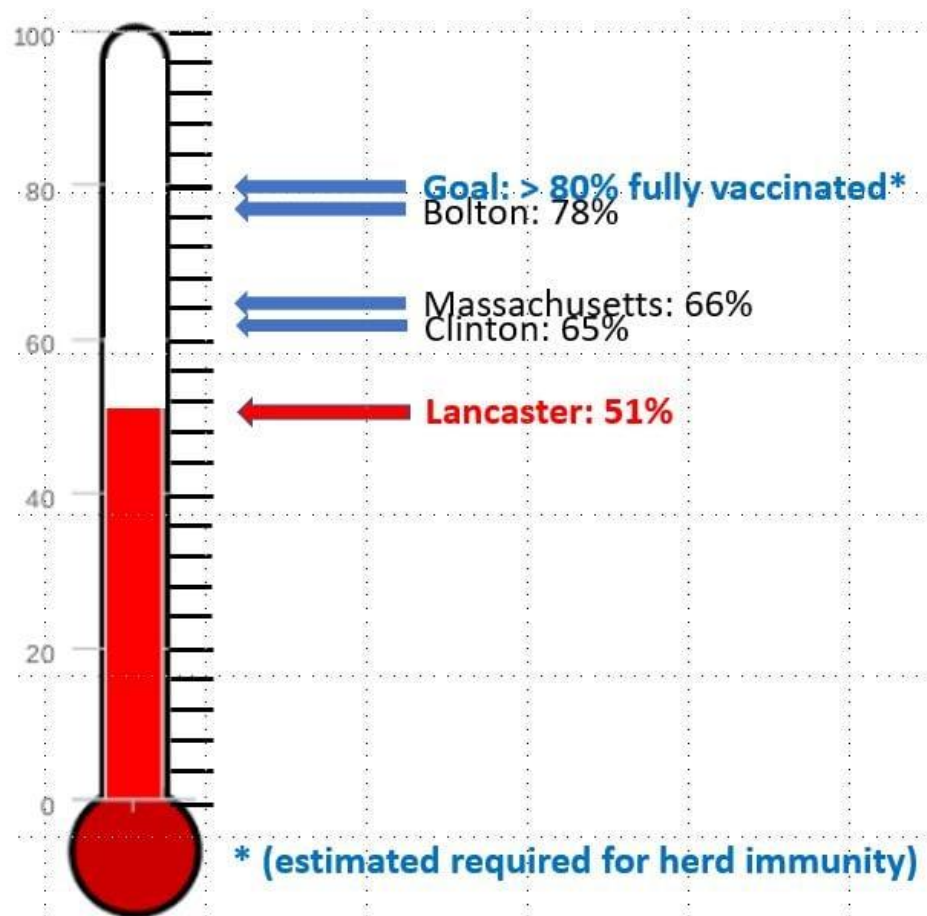
