CDC or Mass Website

Bill Brookings said Nashoba is accepting mask donations that Bridgett has been distributing to businesses. Jeff Paster discussed updating the Board of Health webpage and posting to the main town webpage.

240 Fort Pond Inn Well Variance

Bill Brookings said they are demoing the cinder block foundation and putting a new well in. They are asking for a variance from 50 feet to 30 feet, 50 feet to 21 feet for placement of the new well. Jeff Paster made a motion to approve the variance and Katherine Holden seconded the motion. No discussion. Vote 3-0-0.

<u>Permits</u>

Lot 1 South Meadow-Bill Brookings said this is a redesign pump system for the Boards approval. He said originally, they found elevated levels of arsenic in 2006. The Board required retesting of the soil when the building of the lot was complete. We received a letter from D'Amore Associates requesting a letter from this Board to not require what the previous Board required. **Katherine Holden made a motion to accept the letter by D'Amore Associates and approve with the deletion of the sentence requiring additional testing for arsenic in the future. Jeff Paster seconded the motion. No discussion. Vote 3-0-0.**
