\$1,854k in free cash (\$2.3m sent to DOR for certification this year)
\$358.6k capital requests taken from free cash
\$323k to cover budget deficit
\$291,9k transferred to stabilization
\$323k to cover FY19 budget deficit
Only about \$500k remaining

\$1.4m remaining in stabilization

\$325k remainder of AUC property added to tax base, included in above numbers; not sure AUC will pay No contribution to OPEB this year NetFlix contributed \$250k this year for movie production; no estimate included in FY 20 numbers
