- c. Other ideas for the year 2019 include: wheelchair dance performance; issues around mental health; the 21 panels on the history of disability will be ready for display at the library next year.
- d. No one seems to know what happened to the banner that was posted on the green and was taken down by either the Netflix filming crew and/ or a town employee. The town may end up getting Netflix to pay for replacing the banner.

3. Town matters

- a. 40B project proposal: There is a small working group meeting taking place between the developers representatives, lawyers, and one member of the Town Planning Board of Appeals.
- b. Lesley still needs to investigate the new playground on the Thayer campus for accessibility.
- c. ADA transition plan: a new town planner was hired. No one in the COD has heard anything new about the plan recently nor seen results of the town surveys. Chair McCue will reach out to the new planner in January.
- 4. Emergency preparedness: McCue and Associates continue to work on pamphlet.
- 5. The Minutes from October were accepted as amended.

6. Miscellaneous:

A. Lesley continues to work on sending minutes to the Town Clerk to post on the website.
