 - f. Cumberland Farms "5 corners": Not all aisles are accessible.
 - g. South Lancaster Academy: There are curbs out front and stairs inside the building in many areas with no elevator present.
 - h. College Church: Accessible
- 4. Town website: Mike reminded Diane Reardon to have the website vendor look at the Town website to confirm Accessibility. She has not done it yet.
- 5. Membership: The new building inspector / advisory new member is Tony Zahariadis. Lesley received her letter from the town and has been sworn in for continued membership on the COD.
- 6. Lancaster Accessibility Awareness Month:
 - a. Mike shared a sample of the work McCue and Associates is doing with the "History of Disability" display.
 - b. The new replacement banner has arrived.
