Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday, August 13, 2019 at 7:05 PM** in the Nashaway Meeting Room on the third floor of the Prescott Building, 701 Main Street, to consider the Notice of Intent filed by Barkley Enterprises, LLC on behalf of property owners Raymond & Abigail Rice for proposed work within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands at 0 Shirley Road, further identified as Assessor's Map 5, Lot 54.

The project entails:

Development of a moving and mobile storage facility, associated site access and parking, drainage infrastructure, grading, and landscaping.

The property is located in the IPOD2 Zoning District and EZ-A Retail (Enterprise) Sub-District.
