Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday September 10, 2019 at 7:00 PM** in the Nashaway Meeting Room on the third floor of the Prescott Building, 701 Main Street, to consider the Request for Determination of Applicability filed by property owner Betty Ann Rhodes for proposed work within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Fort Pond at 250 Fort Pond Road, further identified as Assessor's Map 4, Lot 29.

The project entails:

For the protection of human health, safety, and property: removal of a diseased red oak tree, three white pines, and trimming of a second red oak.

The property is located in the residential Zoning District.
