**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
September 24, 2019**



Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday September 24, 2019 at 7:00 PM** in the Nashaway Meeting Room on the third floor of the Prescott Building, 701 Main Street, to consider the Request for Determination of Applicability filed by property owner Fort Pond Inn Road Association for proposed work within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands, and within 200-foot Riverfront Area to Bow Brook, at Fort Pond Inn Road.

The project entails:

Sweeping and re-paving approximately 330 feet of private road servicing ten homes and the YMCA's Camp Lowe.

The property is located in the residential Zoning District.
