**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday August 13, 2019 at 7:00 PM** in the Nashaway Meeting Room on the third floor of the Prescott Building, 701 Main Street, to consider the Request for Determination of Applicability filed by property owner Southern New England Conference of SDA for proposed work within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands and 200-foot Riverfront Area at 198 George Hill Road, further identified as Assessor's Map 37, Lot 160A.

The project entails:

Installation of an underground electrical transmission line to connect South Lancaster Academy to the local National Grid power supply network.

The property is located in the residential Zoning District.
