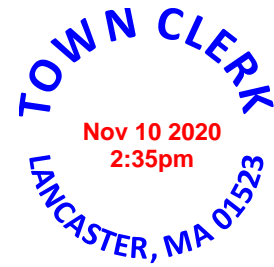

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing remotely via ZOOM® on **Tuesday, November 24, 2020 at 7:05 PM** to consider the Request for Determination of Applicability filed by BRYCAR, LLC on behalf of property owner SCR RC Funding IV, LLC for proposed work within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands at 700 Fort Pond Road, further identified as Assessor's Map 5, Lot 32.P.

The project entails:

Re-grading of several old, overgrown soil piles, followed by restoration loaming and seeding of disturbed areas.

The property is located in the IPOD2 Zoning District.
