Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing remotely via ZOOM® on **Tuesday, November 24, 2020 at 7:15 PM** to consider the Notice of Intent filed by property owner Massachusetts Division of Capital Asset Management and Maintenance (DCAMM) for proposed work within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands at 220 Old Common Road, further identified as Assessor's Map 39, Lot 4.

The project entails:

Removal of a 20,000-gallon Underground Storage Tank (UST) and associated piping. Also, removal of up to 500 cubic yards of petroleum-impacted soil.

The property is located in the Residential Zoning District.
