## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING October 13, 2020

Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing remotely via ZOOM<sup>®</sup> on **Tuesday, October 13, 2020 at 7:10 PM** to consider the Notice of Intent filed by property owner U.S. Army Garrison Fort Devens for proposed work within Isolated Land Subject to Flooding and 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands at Fort Devens South Post Reserve Forces Training Area, further identified as Assessor's Map 11, Parcel 0.

The project entails:

Improvements to the existing South Post Reserve Forces Training Area (RFTA), Hotel Range, which is part of Fort Devens. Approximately half of the site will undergo clearing, grubbing, cutting, and/or filling to support upgrades to the existing Range. Filling will occur within the 100-buffer in several areas and one small isolated depression will be entirely filled. The current use will remain the same.
