**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
May 12, 2020**

Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing remotely via ZOOM® on **Tuesday, May 12, 2020 at 7:05 PM** to consider the Request for Determination of Applicability filed by property owner Fort Pond Inn Road Association for proposed work within Bordering Vegetated Wetlands at Fort Pond Inn Road.

The project entails:

Removal of a 24+” fallen white pine lying across the Bow Brook stream channel and impeding flow into the culvert underneath Fort Pond Inn Road, potentially causing the road to wash out during a heavy rain event.

The property is located in the Residential Zoning District.
