**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday, October 22, 2019 at 7:00 PM** in the Nashaway Meeting Room on the second floor of the Prescott Building, 701 Main Street, to consider the Request for Determination of Applicability filed by the Town of Lancaster for proposed work within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands in the George Hill Road right-of-way at the intersection with Hilltop Road.

The project entails:

Replacement of the existing culvert and associated drainage structures (catch basins).

The property is located in the Residential Zoning District.
