**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday November 12, 2019 at 7:00 PM** in the Nashaway Meeting Room on the second floor of the Prescott Building, 701 Main Street, to consider the Request for Determination of Applicability filed by property owner Laurie B. Kincaid for proposed work within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Spectacle Pond at 206 Fire Road 3, further identified as Assessor's Map 10, Lots 7B and 7D.

The project entails:

Removal of invasive and non-indigenous vegetation to allow healthy growth of native mountain laurel.

The property is located in the Residential Zoning District.
