Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing remotely via ZOOM® on **Tuesday, October 13, 2020 at 7:05 PM** to consider the Request for Determination of Applicability filed by property owner James Lavalley for proposed work within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands at 222 Bolton Road, further identified as Assessor's Map 38, Lot 151.C.

The project entails:

Excavation and re-grading for purposes of landscaping and re-directing existing surface drainage. Also, installation of a 7' x 7' (49 square feet) concrete pad with 3' wide pervious paver access walkway.

The property is located in the Residential Zoning District.
