Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing remotely via ZOOM® on **Tuesday, January 26, 2021 at 7:00 PM** to consider the Notice of Intent filed by David Lynch on behalf of property owners John & Theresa Lynch for proposed work within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands at 710 Sterling Street, further identified as Assessor's Map 40, Lot 2.

The project entails:

Installation of a replacement septic system serving an existing three-bedroom house, including 1,500 gallon septic tank, leach field, and grading, in order to meet the requirements of Title 5.

The property is located in the General Industry Zoning District.
