**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
June 25, 2019**

Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday, June 25, 2019 at 7:00 PM** in the Lancaster Town Hall Auditorium, 695 Main Street, to consider the Request for Determination of Applicability filed by property owner Massachusetts Division of Fisheries and Wildlife for proposed work within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands, 200 Foot Riverfront Area, and Bordering Land Subject to Flooding (100-Year Floodplain) at Seven Bridge Road (Route 117), further identified as Assessor's Map 35, Lot 5.

The project entails:

Placement of gravel to fill in a large puddle that forms when the Nashua River floods, interfering with access to the parking lot at Bolton Flats Wildlife Management Area. The work also includes installation of a corrugated metal culvert pipe under the entrance to the parking lot.

The property is located in the Residential Zoning District and Floodplain Overlay District.
