Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing remotely via ZOOM® on **Tuesday, May 26, 2020 at 7:05 PM** to consider the Request for Determination of Applicability filed by property owner Massachusetts Division of Capital Asset Management (DCAMM) for proposed work within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands at 220 Old Common Road, further identified as Assessor's Map 39, Lot 4.

The project entails:

Abandonment of three existing monitoring wells and replacement of two monitoring wells.

The property is located in the Residential Zoning District.
