Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing remotely via ZOOM® on **Tuesday, June 23, 2020 at 7:05 PM** to consider the Request for Determination of Applicability filed by property owner David Newbould for proposed work within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands at 0 Shirley Road, further identified as Assessor's Map 30, Lot 66.D.

The project entails:

Cutting and removal of 10 – 12 trees. No motorized vehicles will enter the 100-foot Buffer Zone for the removal of logs.

The property is located in the Residential Zoning District.
