

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING July 14, 2020

Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing remotely via ZOOM[®] on **Tuesday, July 14, 2020 at 7:15 PM** to consider the Notice of Intent filed by property owner SATYRS Realty Trust for proposed work within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands at 0 Old Union Turnpike, further identified as Assessor's Map 4, Lot 11.

The project entails:

Restoration of a temporary haul road used for construction purposes. Work to include general re-grading of the road to match surrounding grade, and natural re-vegetation of the roadway.

The property is located in the IPOD1 Zoning District and EZ-A Retail Sub-District.
