**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday, October 9, 2018 at 7:00 PM** in the Nashaway Meeting Room on the third floor of the Prescott Building, 701 Main Street, to consider the Request for Determination of Applicability filed by property owners Eric and Danielle Schmidt for proposed work within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands at 105 Harvard Road, further identified as Assessor's Map 34, Lot 111.

The project entails:

Construction of a 24' by 26' (624 square feet) accessory shed on top of an existing concrete pad.

The property is located in the Residential Zoning District.
