Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday**, **March 24**, **2020 at 7:00 PM** in the Nashaway Meeting Room on the second floor of the Prescott Building, 701 Main Street, to consider the Request for Determination of Applicability filed by property owner Bonnie Mae Smith for proposed work within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Fort Pond at 30 Perry Road, further identified as Assessor's Map 4, Parcel 65.

The project entails:

Power washing and repair of an existing stone retaining wall, replacement of an existing shed, and general property maintenance.

The property is located in the Residential Zoning District.
