**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
June 23, 2020**



Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing remotely via ZOOM® on **Tuesday, June 23, 2020 at 7:10 PM** to consider the Request for Determination of Applicability filed by property owners Peter Steere and Laura O'Neil Steere for proposed work within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands at 8 Farnsworth Way, further identified as Assessor's Map 42, Lot 130.I.

The project entails:

Cutting, removal, and removal of stumps of 35 trees, followed by re-grading of approximately 50' x 75' (3750 square feet; no imported fill will be used) and planting of grass in the cleared area.

The property is located in the Residential Zoning District.
