**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
November 27, 2018**

Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday, November 27, 2018 at 7:00 PM** in the Nashaway Meeting Room on the third floor of the Prescott Building, 701 Main Street, to consider the Request for Determination of Applicability filed by property owner Town of Lancaster for proposed work within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to an Intermittent Stream at 0 Packard Street, further identified as Assessor's Map 34, Lot 107.

The project entails:

Construction of a 31' 6" long by 17' 9" wide (approximately 560 square feet) carport on a concrete slab for parking/storage of the Council on Aging van and non-motorized equipment.

The property is located in the Residential Zoning District.
