The project entails:

Replacement of an existing 12 inch <u>concrete</u> culver/drain with a plastic pipe. A wide mouth plastic inlet fixture will be installed, and the existing outlet headwall will be utilized with the replacement culvert/drain.

The property is located in the Residential Zoning District.
