**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
October 8, 2019**



Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday, October 8, 2019 at 7:00 PM** in the Nashaway Meeting Room on the second floor of the Prescott Building, 701 Main Street, to consider the Request for Determination of Applicability filed by the Town of Lancaster for proposed work within the 200-foot Riverfront Area to the North Nashua River in the southbound side of the Route 70 (Main Street) right-of-way from the Nashua River Bridge to Whitcomb Drive.

The project entails:

Reconstruction of the existing sidewalk, including concrete wheelchair ramp construction, high visibility crosswalk installation, and concrete sidewalk reconstruction, which may include removing and re-setting of curb and transition curb.

The property is located in the Residential Zoning District.
