Spratt Corp. for proposed work in the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands at 290 Langen Road, further identified as Assessor's Map 29, Lot 1.A. The project entails:

Repair and maintenance of the slope bordering a parking area for vehicles.

The property is located in the Residential Zoning District.
