Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing remotely via ZOOM® on **Tuesday, April 27, 2021 at 7:05 PM** to consider the Notice of Intent filed by property owners David & Leigh Sarnoski for proposed work within Riverfront Area and 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands at 1312 North Main Street, further identified as Assessor's Map 30, Lot 156.B.

The project entails:

Construction of a garage addition, breezeway, and porous pavement walkway, installation of a drywell to manage rooftop stormwater runoff, and expansion of driveway pavement.

The property is located in the Residential Zoning District.
