Discussion, 2078 and 2089 Main Street

Present: Richard Cunningham

Mr. Koonce gave the Commission a brief background of the area and what has been happening on the site. Mr. Koonce stated that the Commission has had issues with the property before. Mr. Koonce stated that Mr. Cunningham has been to the office and is concerned with a dumpster and parked cars that maybe within a drainage easement at close to a wetland.
