Discussion, Update to the Open Space and Recreation Plan

Present: Cara Sanford, Open Space and Recreation Plan Committee

Ms. Cara Sanford stated that the original Open Space and Recreation Plan was drafted in 2007 and it is now time to update the plan. Ms. Sanford informed the Commission that she is not doing as much with the update as she did when the plan was first drafted.

Ms. Sanford is working on updating the resource needs and protection needs section of the open space and recreation plan and want to ask the Commission for their opinion on what they feel is needed in the town for resources and protection.

Ms. Sanford stated that she will take the comments she received tonight as part of the discussion and create a draft of the updated Resource and Protection section of the Open Space Plan.

Mr. Farmer suggested that the Commission draft a warrant article for town meeting to appropriate the funds for the parking area.

Mr. Koonce will draft a warrant article for the Commission to review.
