There being a quorum present, Acting Chair Tom Christopher called the meeting to order at 7:02 PM.

### <u>Public Hearing – Request for Determination of Applicability; James Crosby & Lauren Jennings;</u> <u>186 Fort Pond Inn Road</u> <u>Present: James Crosby, Applicant and Property Owner</u>

Mr. Crosby stated that there are four large white pine trees, three of which are in the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Fort Pond, growing very close to his house; he is very worried they present a danger to the house in that they may come down in a high wind storm, or be struck by lightning. He also said the needles and branches pile up on his deck and roof, and need to be constantly removed.

Conservation Agent David Koonce agreed there is a legitimate safety concern with the trees. He said pine trees have comparatively shallow roots, and even though the four trees in question are of large diameters with extensive root systems, there is still a risk they could fall in a severe thunderstorm or micro-burst. He also said that trees on this property have been struck by lightning in the past, most recently in 2013, with the Commission approving the removal of lightning-damaged trees through a Negative Determination of Applicability issued to the previous owners in 2014. He recommended a Negative Determination in this case, with the condition that he be notified at least 72 hours in advance of the start of work, and within 72 hours after the completion.
