Recreation Committee Update:

Trails

- Stephen would like to start to plan a trail walk/hike for the last Saturday of each month.
 - February 23: Family Animal Tracking Walk 10am 12pm, Lancaster Town Forest
 - Andrea will reach out to the local Boy Scouts and Stephen will reach out to volunteers at the Mass Audubon Field Naturalist Certificate Program for assistance with walks/hikes
 - Stephen is interested in including the annual Bolton Orchards walk, an "Owl Prowl", a Mushroom Walk and others.
- Lancaster Recreation will look for an alternative location to hold the fishing outing next year that would hopefully yield better catching results. Would like to partner with the same people that ran it this year.
- Stephen talks about introducing and Earth Day Clean Up day. It is mentioned that there is already a Town Wide Clean Up Day, but perhaps the two events could be merged.
- Stephen would like to do an Equipment Sale next year. Would like to combine it with an activity by the new playground.
- Jay Moody asks if there is interest in Geocaching. Stephen responds that he could do such an event and thinks it's a great addition.
- No update on Cook Conservation bridge work.
- Working with Mark9 is still a possibility. Stephen will be in touch with them.
- Dexter Drumlin walk is rescheduled until January 26th due to weather conditions. Committee members will be in touch with appropriate people to reschedule event.

Town Beach

- Andrea, Rick, and Orlando went through the beach and talked about improvements that can be made.
- Dave Carr will donate a refrigerator to the beach.
- He also asks if there are any Eagle Scouts looking for a project to do for the community.
- Stephen suggests a Free Library at the beach where people can take and donate books as they please.
- Mark shares a new idea for surveillance at the beach. For \$250, Cobra has a system that includes 4 cameras, a DVR, and no internet is required. We would also need new signage to announce the presence of cameras.
- The bathrooms/shed need painting at the beach. Ken suggests a "team building" day for the lifeguards and attendance to paint the facility.
- Will still need to discuss the Point of Sale device at the upcoming meeting. Katie and Ken will further look into the requirements for such a device.

Old and New Business/Recreation Director Update

- Orlando put Andrea in contact with Joan DeAngelis who runs a program at NRHS for students needing life skill training. Insurance would be covered.
 Joe asks if we can make a donation to the program as they do not charge for their work.
