Under the provisions of Chapter 166, Section 22 of the General Laws, and any additions thereto or amendments thereof, a Public Hearing is scheduled for Tuesday, 6:05 pm on January 2, 2018 in the Dexter Room of the Thayer Memorial Library, 717 Main Street, Lancaster, MA to consider a petition submitted by National Grid, requesting permission to locate poles, wires, and fixtures, including the necessary sustaining and protecting fixture, along and across the following public way:

George Hill Road – National Grid to install 1 SO Pole on George Hill Road beginning at a point approximately 600 feet East of the centerline of the intersection of Hill Top Road. National Grid to install 1 40C2 pole across from Pole 37.

Also permission to lay and maintain underground laterals, cables and wires in the above or intersecting public ways for the purpose of making connections with such poles and buildings as each of said petitioners may desire for distributing purposes.
