**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
May 25, 2021**

Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing remotely via ZOOM® on **Tuesday, May 25, 2021 at 7:00 PM** to consider the Notice of Intent filed by property owner Daniel McCarty for proposed work within Land Under Waterbodies and Waterways (Fort Pond) at 306 Fort Pond Road, further identified as Assessor's Map 4, Lot 26.

The project entails:

Demolition and replacement of approximately 100 feet in length and three courses in height of 8" x 16" masonry, along with the removal of three pine and three oak trees.

The property is located in the Residential Zoning and Aquifer Protection Overlay Districts.
