**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
September 12, 2017**

Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing at the Lancaster Community Center, 695 Main Street (behind Thayer Memorial Library) on **Tuesday, September 12, 2017 at 7:10 PM** to consider the Request for Determination of Applicability filed by property owners Daniel and Sabina Bettencourt for proposed work within the 100-foot Buffer Zone and shoreline to Big Spectacle Pond at 140 Fire Road 12, further identified as Assessor's Map 10, Lot 112. The project entails:

Cutting and removal of approximately 10 trees (stumps to remain), trimming several others, and removal by hand of accumulated junk, trash, and organic yard debris.

The property is located in the Residential Zoning District.
