

## Moderna Booster Friday!

The Nashoba Associated Boards of Health, in conjunction with your local Boards of Health is conducting a Booster Clinic at Clear Path for Veterans of New England, 84 Antietam St, Devens, MA 01434 on 10/29/21 from 11AM to 2PM. Sorry for the short notice, things are moving fast!

The site will offer Moderna Booster shots for those who are fully vaccinated and are eligible to receive a Booster according to the recommendation from the Department of Public Health; to check if you are eligible visit: [https://www.mass.gov/.../covid-19-booster-frequently....](https://www.mass.gov/.../covid-19-booster-frequently...)

The clinic will not provide first doses of the vaccine.

Who is eligible to get a booster?

- People who are immunocompromised
- Individuals who are immunocompromised due to particular health conditions have been eligible for a booster dose of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine since August 13.
- People who received the Moderna vaccine

You are now eligible for a booster dose 6 months after your second shot if you are:

- Age 65+
- Age 18+ who live in long term care settings
- Age 18+ who have underlying medical conditions
- Age 18+ who live or work in a high-risk setting

Mixing vaccines

- If I got my second Moderna shot at least 6 months ago and I meet the eligibility criteria, I can get Moderna, Pfizer or J&J now
- People who received the J&J vaccine
- You are now eligible for a booster dose 2 months after your initial dose of the J&J vaccine if you are 18 years old or older.

Mixing vaccines

- If I got a J&J shot at least 2 months ago, I can get Moderna, Pfizer or J&J now
