**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing remotely via ZOOM® on **Tuesday, April 13, 2021 at 7:15 PM** to consider the Notice of Intent filed by property owner Patrick Mulligan for proposed work within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands at 2056 North Main Street, further identified as Assessor's Map 24, Lot 34.

The project entails:

Installation of a replacement septic system serving an existing three-bedroom house, including 1,500 gallon septic tank and connecting lines, leach field, and grading, in order to meet the requirements of Title 5.

The property is located in the Residential Zoning District.
