NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING April 27, 2021

Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing remotely via ZOOM® on **Tuesday**, **April 27**, **2021 at 7:05 PM** to consider the Notice of Intent filed by property owners David & Leigh Sarnoski for proposed work within Riverfront Area and 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands at 1312 North Main Street, further identified as Assessor's Map 30, Lot 156.B.

The project entails:

Construction of a garage addition, breezeway, and porous pavement walkway, installation of a drywell to manage rooftop stormwater runoff, and expansion of driveway pavement.

The property is located in the Residential Zoning District.
