The project entails:

Restoration of approximately 9,400 square feet of altered Bordering Vegetated Wetlands along with associated 100-foot Buffer Zone, including replantation of overstory, shrub, and herbaceous layers, with supplemental hydric soils where necessary.

The property is located in the Residential Zoning District.
