1. Easy access bathtubs:
  - a. Septic System – Feces backs up into tubs and it is very hard to clean for elderly and especially the handicapped among us because leaning over the side of the tub is hazardous as well as stepping into the tub that has been filled with feces.
2. Handicapped ramps and porches:
  - a. A center rail, between two apartments, would help the disabled person whose current handicap is on the same side as the existing railing.
  - b. Repair existing railings – paint/scrape of old paint because the old paint gets in our hands like splinters.
3. Sidewalks and street
  - a. Uneven sidewalks – not safe to walk on – can't exercise close to home – need to walk in the street.
4. Handicapped/disabled apartment – lower stoves and sinks
