Approval of Minutes

• Minutes of the December meeting were unanimously approved without any corrections.

Board of Health

Jeff Paster reported the following:

- Current prevalent COVID variant is XBB.1.5 which is a variant of the Omicron variant.
- Numbers are slowly decreasing which is encouraging.
- He is recommending face masks indoors in public places.
- The next BOH educational session will be held on 2/21/23 at 12:00 at the LCC.
- Please send him requests and ideas for future educational sessions.

Nashoba Regional School District

Kirk Downing discussed the proposed school project.

- He plans to educate the community on the proposed school project and will be posting a schedule of events on social media.
- Board Briefs 1 & 2 were shared for review.
- The current HS was built in the early 1960s. Windows can't be replaced as they support the building structure.
- In Mid-May 2023 he will have an estimate of cost and the school committee will vote on the project.
- There will be a second vote to incur the debt.
- He discussed the process as well as classroom standards.
- He plans to share the School Attending report.
- The new proposed HS can handle growth.
- He encouraged participants to watch his last meeting on 1/18/23 to better understand the budget.
- The public is also encouraged to view the strategic plan.
- Victoria Petracca discussed new potential affordable housing population increase and would like to work together with the school district to ensure the new school can accommodate new enrollment.

Affordable Housing Trust

Victoria Petracca discussed Affordable Housing Trust but was speaking as a resident.

- The Affordable Housing Trust started meeting in January 2021 with goals of producing new housing and preserving current housing as well as policy.
- There are 6 members, 5 of whom are appointed town residents.
- She invited the public to view current information and inventory under The Affordable Housing Trust tab on the town's website.
- Currently, 2010 Census data is being used, although shortly the 2020 Census data will be used and with this, 12% affordable housing will be needed to be within compliance.
