What is Community Preservation Act (CPA)?

The Community Preservation Act (CPA) allows Communities to establish a fund that is specifically dedicated to:

- Historic Preservation
- Open Space
- Recreation
- Affordable Housing



Where does the money come from?

Funds are collected as a 1% annual surcharge to local property taxes.

- A little more than \$55/year for average Lancaster residential assessment
- Exemption for first \$100,000 of assessed property value (applies to all)
- Exemption for qualified ownership of Lancaster's (a) low income housing
 & (b) low income & moderate income senior housing
- A taxpayer receiving a regular property tax abatement or exemption will also receive a pro rate reduction in surcharge



The CPA surcharge is a tax but different

- Funds raised receive an additional, annual State contribution
- The Community decides how funds will be spent
- Can be used as matching funds that are required by many State and Federal Grants
- Funds are dedicated to projects that are typically underfunded or unfunded by the town
- CPA facilitates knowledge of and participation in proposed community projects

How are funds managed and dispersed?

- CPA Committee facilitates proposals for all projects
- Minimum 10% of collected funds is allocated to each of the 3 primary categories:
 - Historic Preservation 10%
 - Open Space & Recreation 10%
 - Affordable Housing 10%
 - Adminstrative Fees (unused funds go back to the fund)
- Allows flexibility so that the Community can determine allocation for remaining 65%

How are projects chosen?

The Community Preservation Committee reviews project proposals and submits recommended projects for approval at May Town Meeting.

Lancaster residents have the final say in project approvals.
