**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
November 26, 2019**

Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday November 26, 2019 at 7:05 PM** in the Nashaway Meeting Room on the second floor of the Prescott Building, 701 Main Street, to consider the Notice of Intent filed by property owners Brendan & Ashley Laughlin for proposed work within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands at 348 Mill Street Extension, further identified as Assessor's Map 42, Lot 129.

The project entails:

Repair/upgrade of an existing septic system serving a three-bedroom house in order to bring the system into compliance with the requirements of Title 5, including installation of a new septic tank, pump chamber, and leaching facility.

The property is located in the Residential Zoning District.
