Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 131, Section 40 (Wetlands Protection Act), and the Lancaster Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Lancaster Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing remotely via ZOOM® on **Tuesday, May 26, 2020 at 7:00 PM** to consider the Request for Determination of Applicability filed by property owner SATYRS Realty Trust for proposed work within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands at 0 Old Union Turnpike, further identified as Assessor's Map 4, Lot 11.

The project entails:

Restoration of an existing field area which was disturbed while being used as a haul road for the construction of a solar energy project to the west of the subject parcel.

The property is located in the IPOD1 Zoning District and EZ-A Retail Sub-District.
