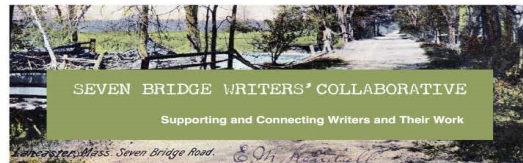

**Writing on the Trail
with Tim Castner**

Join local historian and writer, Tim Castner, for a walk— through time — down Prospect Hill to the shore of Glacial Lake Nashua. Learn how landscape clues can be combined with traditional documents to enrich our stories about the past. Tim's experience as a history educator and his work with the Lancaster Town Forest Committee, Flats Mentor Farm, and Freedom's Way National Heritage Area, gives him a unique perspective on the environmental history of the area. In this workshop, he will look at the geologic history of the area with reference to the indigenous, colonial, and early national history of Harvard and its environs. Participants will explore the varied landscapes of the Fruitlands property while participating in a series of brief writing exercises designed to stimulate thinking about both history and writing.

Tim Castner has worked as a history teacher for the past twenty years at Nashoba Regional High School. His publications include chapters on The Great Awakening and The Constitutional Convention in Conflicts in American History: A Documentary Encyclopedia, 8-Volume Set, and a recent collaboration with Paul D. Hanson for his book, A Political History of the Bible in America.

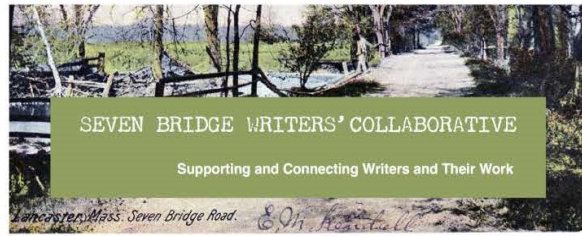

Get your nature fix, practice mindfulness, shuffle off stress, and become more creative! This is a session that leads us outside to use all of our senses, to be mindful and to pay attention, and to write about what we experience. We will "discover" the neighborhood with fresh eyes and ears. First, we'll do a few exercises to get our creative juices flowing. Then we'll explore the natural areas behind the buildings. Along the way, we will use all of our senses to increase our awareness and to relieve daily stresses simultaneously. We won't have to go far to find interesting material. Participants are guaranteed to see, hear, and touch something brand-new and intriguing this time, even if they are familiar with this place. And they'll come away with partial or finished pieces of writing or artwork, too. Feel free to bring your own journal or sketchbook. Small journals and writing utensils will be provided. This session will last at least 90 minutes.

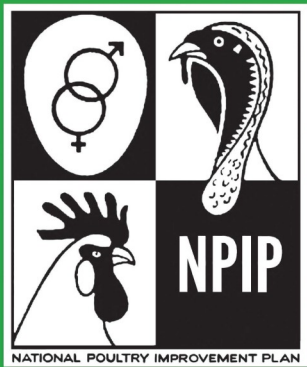

Things you should know:

1. If you sell or give away hatching eggs, chicks or grown birds, they must be from a tested flock (MGL Ch 129 sec 26B).
2. If poultry leaves your property for exhibition, they must also be from a tested flock.
3. Test your flock annually; test all chickens, turkeys, upland gamebirds, guinea or peafowl over 16 weeks of age.
